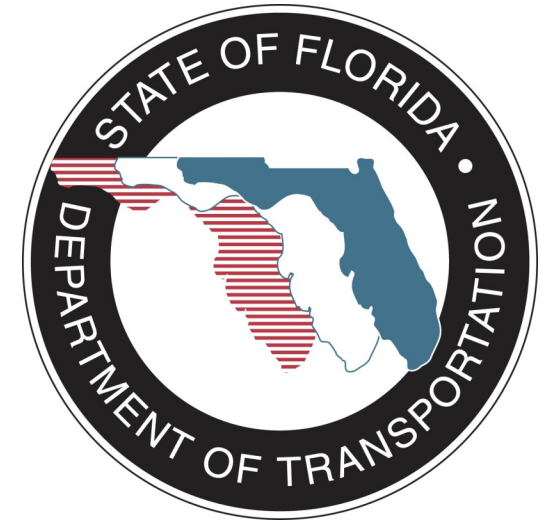

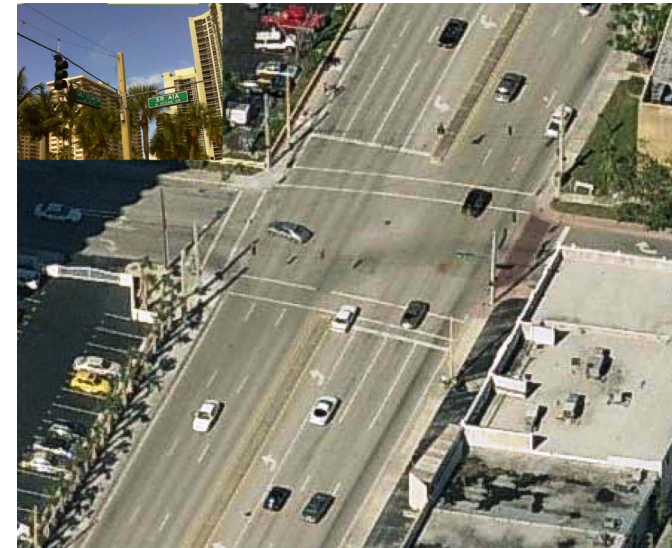
## Project Scope

- Removing old asphalt
- Repaving A1A
- Adding new bike lanes in both directions
- Adding curb and gutter
- Installing ADA ramps at intersections
- Extending left turn lanes
- Adding video detection system on traffic signals
- Installing mast arm at signalized intersections
- Minor landscaping from 32nd Street to Flamingo Drive (*Contractor is responsible for one year of landscape maintenance after project completion. City of Fort Lauderdale will then be responsible for maintenance.*)

## Construction Schedule

Construction is anticipated to start May 7, 2012 and is expected to be complete by December 2012.

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## Construction Cost

The total cost of the A1A between Oakland Park Boulevard and Flamingo Avenue is \$2.1 million.
