This letter serves to confirm that at its October 28, 2015 Executive Board meeting, the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Transportation Management Association (TMA) approved the following changes to the Galt Link route:

- Extension of the service north into Lauderdale-by-the-Sea to provide more connectivity with the Pelican Hopper community bus service operated by the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea; and
- Elimination of the existing portion of the route along US-1 north of Oakland Park Boulevard that services the Holy Cross and Imperial Point hospitals, due to low ridership.
