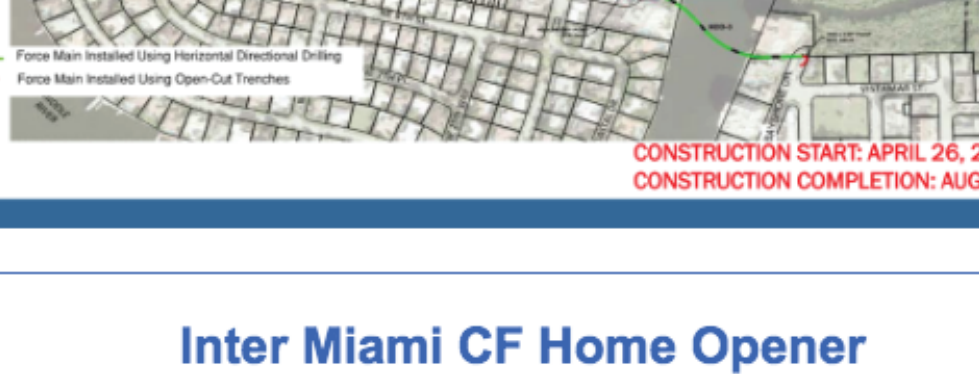

The City of Fort Lauderdale is replacing the force main along NE 9 Street between Middle River Drive and Intracoastal Drive. Project Overview

Replacement and up-sizing of an aging existing force main along NE 9th St. between Middle River Dr. and Intracoastal Dr., including replacement of subaqueous crossing of the Intracoastal Waterway to a connection with an existing force main on Bayshore Dr., project also includes storm sewer improvements and installation of a tidal check valve on west side of Intracoastal Waterway.



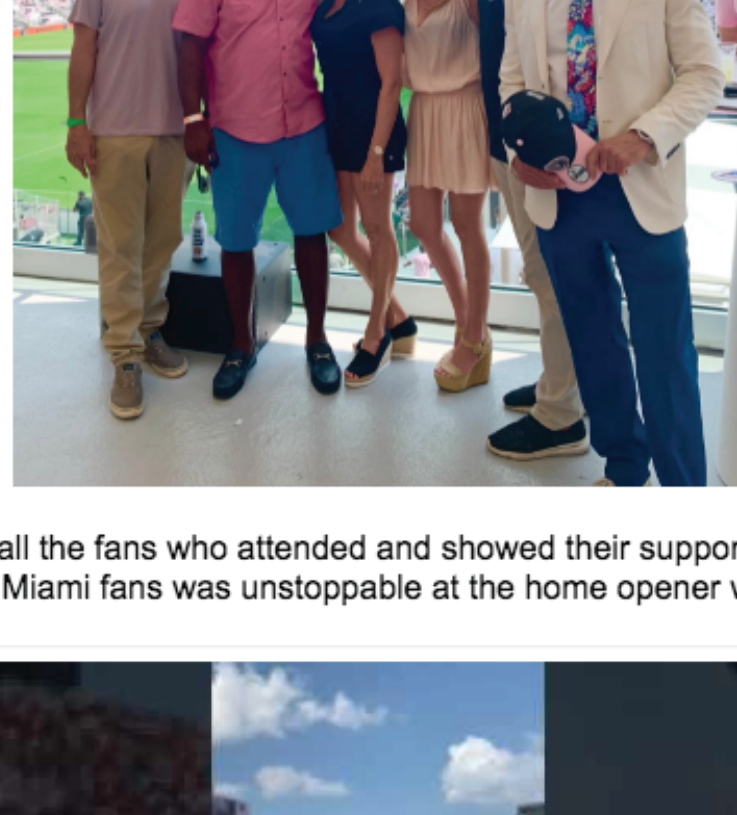

Inter Miami CF Home Opener

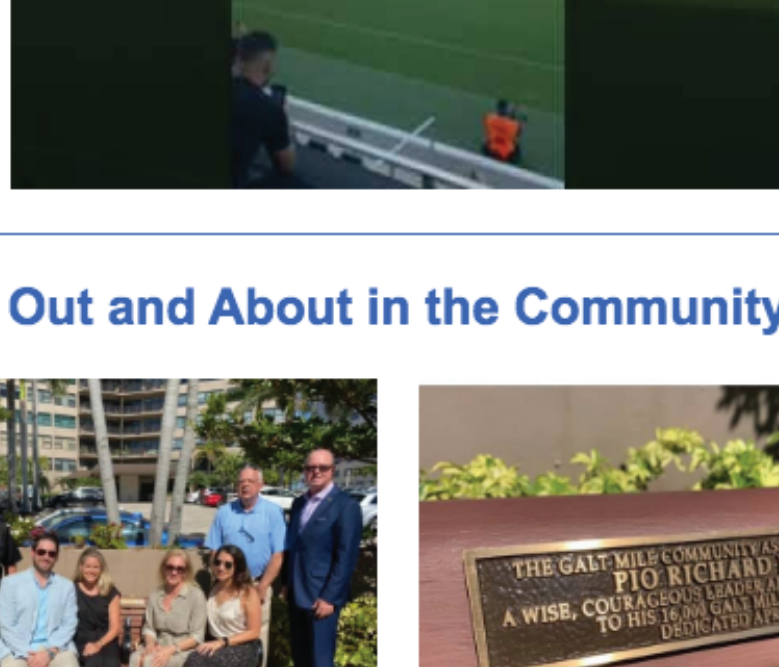
