





DeSantis has announced his proposed 2022 state budget. The proposed \$99.7 billion "Freedom First Budget" focuses on protecting Floridians with record funding for education, environmental resources, and law enforcement officers. This includes \$15 billion in reserves, \$421 million dedicated to school safety and mental health initiatives, \$600 million for Everglades restoration and \$195 million for water quality improvements. He has also proposed a new fuel-tax holiday to help alleviate the increase in gas prices. I look forward to working on the 2022 budget as we head back up to Tallahassee after the holidays.
