Dear Community Members,

Spring is here and Broward County celebrated our beautiful environment with two great events, early in the month, the 21st Annual Water Matters Day and the 46th Annual Waterway Cleanup. Thank you to all those who participated. We also recognized National 311 Day with appreciation for our call takers at our call center. Finally, we celebrated Women's History Month recognizing the amazing efforts of all women, both past and present that make a difference in our lives and in the world.

Broward County's Human Services Department

Broward's Human Services Department provides a multitude of services for anyone in our community that needs assistance. The work our staff does, day in and day out is above and beyond to help those in need. I want to take the time and showcase the many services provided by our Human Service Department, which includes the Community Partnership Division, Crisis Intervention and Support Division, Broward Addiction Recovery Division (BARC), Family Success Administration Division (FSAD), Elderly and Veterans Services Division, and Housing Options, Solutions and Supports Division (HOSS).

- <u>Community Partnership Division</u> provides services to vulnerable residents through funding opportunities, quality services and collaborative solutions. Through grant funding opportunities for public and private entities, the Division oversees contracts for both Children Services Administration Section (i.e., behavioral health, special needs, youth housing and more for children and families in need) and Health Care Services Section (i.e., behavioral health, therapeutic interventions, special population and more for adult healthcare needs).
- <u>Crisis Intervention and Support Division</u> meets the needs of children, adults and families
 in crisis with timely, coordinated and quality services. The division's areas of work
 include Justice Services which coordinates alternative justice program to reduce costs
 associated with the incarceration of non-violent offenders (i.e., Juvenile Civil Citation,
 Broward Youth Reentry program and more) and the Nancy J. Cotterman Center that is
 the only accredited Children's Advocacy and certified Rape Crisis Program in the
 County.

- <u>Broward Addiction Recovery Division</u> provides services that heal individuals and families impacted by substance abuse. This includes assessments, detoxification, medication assisted treatment, residential treatment services and more with a dedicated team of doctors, counselors, caseworkers and mental health specialists.
- *Family Success Administration Division* aids individuals and families in achieving economic success and social stability. They provide emergency assistance (short term rental/utilities), emergency rental assistance (Covid related), electric bill assistance, water bill assistance and a financial capability program.
- <u>Elderly and Veterans Services Division</u> empowers elders, Veterans and their families with support that promotes self-sufficiency and aging in place. This includes services for individuals 60 and older through community care for the elderly, home care for the elderly, adult day care programs and much more. Additionally, Veterans Services helps Veterans applying or appealing decisions for federal VA benefits. During emergency activations this division is also tasked with ensuring all clients have an emergency plan.
- Housing Options, Solutions and Supports is the new Homeless Initiative providing services to the homeless population from coordinated entry and assessment to permanent housing solutions. Some of the new services provided include, trained medical professionals near major areas of concern (i.e., Broward Blvd. Bus Terminal) on a weekly basis to treat individuals that may need medical assistance, or the new Broward4Homeless.org website/app that provides anyone access to all services.

With a budget of approximately \$175 million, which includes about \$98 million from our General Fund dollars and a combination of state and federal appropriations, the Human Services Department is tasked with a major feat to enhance the quality of life for Broward County residents through innovative and integrated health and human services programs. I want to personally thank each member of this Department for their hard work and dedication for some of the most vulnerable residents in our community.

Celebrating 311 Day

This month, Broward County celebrated the amazing work that our 311-Call Center does, year around, for the residents and visitors in our community during this year's National 311 Day. Broward County's 311 Call Center provides a single point of contact for the services and programs offered by more than 60 agencies comprising Broward County government. In 2022, the 311 Call Center answered more than 342,000 calls. The Call Center handles calls in any language and has English, Spanish and Creole-speaking specialists on staff. Conservation Pays

Broward Water Partnership Program (BPW) is a partnership of local governments, including 15 municipalities and water utilities who have come together to help save water, save money and protect the environment. Through its partnership with BPW, Broward County's Water and Wastewater Services Division offers rebates through a credit on the water

bill for qualifying customers. Residents can apply for a rebate of up to \$100 for replacing old, inefficient toilets with WaterSense® certified High-Efficiency Toilets. Residents are encouraged to visit ConservationPays.com to check your eligibility and for further information.



Additionally, Broward County offers residential irrigation rebates for qualifying homeowners in partner areas. The program application is currently live and there are four rebate options provided that will assist homeowners in achieving an efficient and digital, weather -based irrigation system. Sea Turtle Nesting Season

Sea turtle nesting season has begun and runs through October 31. Three species of sea turtles typically nest on Broward's beaches. Residents and visitors are encouraged to stay away from nests. If you live along the beach, reduce the use of artificial lighting so as not to confuse sea turtles who may mistake the light for the moon reflecting on the ocean.



Last year, the Broward County Sea Turtle Conservation Program (BCSTCP) documented more than 3,650 nests on the County's 24-mile coastline (including the Dr. Von D. Mizell-
