- Fort Lauderdale Mayor Dean Trantalis Spoke about several issues, including the Galt Mile, water treatment plant, city infrastructure, broken sewer pipe, hockey team, ribbon cutting at aquatic center, soccer stadium, pickle ball, new courthouse and more.
