State of the County

On November 28, I presented the State of the County Address as my final official action as your County Mayor. We've made some great progress this year in all areas of our community. I was able to visit all 31 municipalities to ensure that each commission is aware that the County is here to help as we work together on many regional issues. The Board passed an \$8.6 billion budget without raising the millage rate. This budget meets the Commission's priorities like public safety, affordable housing, economic development and continuing to provide the many services the County is proud to deliver to those most in need. Additionally, the Board


Broward County's New Government Center Update

On November 14, the County Commission heard from County Administration and our consultant on the options for the site location for the new County Government Center. The three sites in review are all located in the downtown Fort Lauderdale area and include 201

W. Broward Blvd site (recently acquired by the County), the existing Governmental Center site and the Broward Bus Terminal site. The Commission had a lengthy discussion and ultimately decided that the site at 201 W. Broward Blvd. is best. Stay tuned for more information.



Record Sea Turtle Season



Sea turtle season runs from March 1-October 31 and this year we are happy to report that preliminary counts from the Broward County Sea Turtle Conservation Program (BCSTCP) revealed a record year. There have been an astonishing 4,328 nests documented. Even more exciting, 2023 was the first time in the history of the BCSTCP that record-breaking numbers were recorded for all three species that nest in Broward County. Among the total nests were 3,445 loggerhead, 798 green turtle and 85 leatherbacks. I believe this success is due to residents, visitors, and businesses'

great effort to reduce lighting impacts on our beaches and I thank you for your efforts in protecting the wildlife in our community.

Manatee Season runs from November 15- March 31. As part of the <u>County's Manatee Conservation Program</u>, the Natural Resources Division reminds boaters to look out for manatees on County waterways (including the Intracoastal Waterway and side canals).
