


Broward Commuter Rail North Update

The Broward County Commissioners recently took a major step forward on the Broward Commuter Rail North (BCR-North) Project. The Board adopted a resolution and passed a budget resolution for \$20 million for the Project Development and Environmental (PD&E) activities for the project. As you may know, this project will provide greater connectivity and service to the northern portion of the County and ultimately Palm Beach County. The resolution supports the proposed Locally Preferred Alternative for BCR-North in order to move the process forward, without specifically designating a choice for the New River Crossing. This will allow for the City of Fort Lauderdale to continue their work on providing the County with a feasible option for the New River Crossing by October of this year. Drainage Work in Fort Lauderdale

Broward County's Public Works' Highway and Bridge Maintenance Division will be performing drainage system cleaning, inspection, and small repairs on NE 6th Avenue from Wilton Drive to NE 38th Street in Fort Lauderdale. Funded by the Transportation Surtax, the work is scheduled to begin Monday, April 28 and be completed in November 2025. Work will commence at the southern end of the project limits and advance north. During this work, one lane will be closed to vehicle traffic during off-peak hours, while the adjacent lane will remain open, with flaggers assisting these efforts. Port Everglades Update

Broward County's Port Everglades continues to grow its business in Cargo and continues to receive national accolades. This month, I had the opportunity to attend welcome

ceremonies for two new cargo ships from Crowley and Accordia. The Crowley ship, *Quetzal*, which services the U.S., Dominican Republic and Central America, is notable in that it is powered by Liquified Natural Gas (LNG), a cleaner fuel. Accordia's *M/V Challenger* ship launched a new full-container weekly service between Port Everglades, Cap-Haïtien (Haiti) and Mariel (Cuba). Accordia Shipping is the only 100% minority owned Vessel-Operating Common Carrier headquartered in Fort Lauderdale and proudly rooted in Broward County. We are excited to welcome the new services to Port Everglades as we continue to diversify the Port's portfolio.





Additionally, I want to give a major congratulations to Port Everglades and its staff for recently earning high marks from the North American Marine Environment Protection Association for its commitment to sustainability through the organization's Maritime Sustainability Passport Program.
